Duties: Under the direction and supervision of the Recreation Supervisor, the Gymnastics Instructor is responsible for teaching a variety of skills to students. They are responsible for general classroom management, planning, skills instruction, strength training, instruction of routines, and spotting students. Instructors are responsible in assisting the Recreation Supervisor in selecting competition dates and uniforms, distributing flyers to parents and recruiting parent volunteers for the IPDGC Gymnastics and Tumbling competitions. Additional duties include equipment set- and clean-up. This is an at-will position.
